

THE MCKINLEY FOUNDATION FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIP

The McKinley Foundation at the University of Illinois was named for US Senator William McKinley, a well-known humanitarian and benefactor in this community and the University of Illinois. It was built at the height of the Depression and dedicated in 1930. Throughout its 100 plus years, The McKinley Foundation, in cooperation with the McKinley Memorial Presbyterian Church, has sought to live out its inclusive faith and socially conscious convictions through social justice work and human service.

AMOUNT

The McKinley Foundation Freshman Scholarship is an award of \$2,000. Up to two scholarships are awarded each year by The McKinley Foundation Board of Directors.

CRITERIA

The McKinley Foundation Freshman Scholarship is available exclusively to entering freshmen who will be residents of Presby Hall at the University of Illinois in Champaign, Illinois, for the coming academic year (2018-2019).

Preference is given to those students who meet the following criteria:

- Financial need
- Civic engagement or volunteer service, especially for social justice issues
- Academic achievement

TO APPLY

1. **Application:** Complete the form that begins on page 3. Be sure to sign the application agreement on page 5.
2. **Essay:** Include an essay of no more than 500 words that briefly describes your academic interests and how they relate to your career objectives.
3. **References:** Provide three references from people other than relatives that attest to your suitability to be awarded this scholarship, e.g., current or former supervisors, professors, high school teachers, coaches, clergy members. Preferably, one of your references should speak specifically about your civic engagement or volunteer activities.

You may collect and attach reference letters to your application. Alternately, reference letters may be sent directly to the Scholarship Awards Committee.

4. **Transcripts:** Arrange to have your high school provide a copy of your final grade report. A photocopy is acceptable.
