AMOUNT

The Ullman Scholarship is an award of \$2,000.

CRITERIA

The Ullman Scholarship is available exclusively to residents of Presby Hall at the University of Illinois in Champaign, Illinois. Other considerations include:

- Financial need
- Civic engagement
- Academic achievement
- Study of music

TO APPLY

1. **Application:** Complete the form that begins on page 2. Be sure to sign the application agreement on page 5.
2. **Essay:** Include an essay of no more than 500 words that briefly describes your academic and social justice interests and how they relate to your career objectives.
3. **References:** Provide three references from people other than relatives that attest to your suitability to be awarded this scholarship, e.g., current or former supervisors, professors, high school teachers, coaches, clergy members. You may collect and attach reference letters to your application. Alternately, reference letters may be sent directly to the Scholarship Awards Committee.
4. **Transcripts:** Arrange to have your current educational institution send a copy of your transcript to the Scholarship Awards Committee. A photocopy is acceptable. If you are an incoming freshman, have your high school provide a copy of your final grade report.

Application Agreement

All scholarship money will be paid directly to Presby Hall by the academic year. One half will be distributed in the fall semester, the second half in the spring. Should no student be awarded this scholarship, the award defaults into the Share Grant Fund of McKinley Memorial Presbyterian Church. The Session (governing board) of McKinley Church shall act as the final arbiter of the scholarship award.

In accepting this scholarship award, you agree to meet the following requirements. Failure to comply may result in forfeiture of your scholarship aid.

- Maintain full-time academic studies at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.
- Refrain from any actions that may bring disrepute to McKinley Memorial Presbyterian Church or the McKinley Foundation, as judged by the Scholarship Awards Committee. These activities may include, but are not limited to, arrest for alcohol-related offenses, arrest for illegal drug possession, possession of firearms or other weapons on McKinley Foundation property or any of its affiliates, sexual assault or sexual harassment, vandalism, serious infractions of Presby Hall rules and regulations, or other felonious activities.
- Make yourself available for media interviews as directed by the McKinley Church and Foundation, and to have your name and likeness used in McKinley Church and Foundation marketing materials.
- Write an acknowledgment letter to the scholarship donors (or their heirs) thanking them for their assistance.
